



Diversity Promise Scholarship

Southern Utah University prioritizes the success of students in all aspects of their education. For the upcoming 2023-2024 academic year, we invite you to apply for our Diversity Promise Scholarship. The aim of this scholarship is to eliminate financial barriers for our underserved student populations to promote access to an equitable education. This need based scholarship can award up to full tuition for the academic year. Students who are not Pell grant eligible can still be considered for the scholarship. This scholarship is renewable for 8 academic semesters as long as you maintain a 2.0 GPA, complete 70% of your courses, and are a full time student.

In order to apply for the scholarship you must:

- Complete the FAFSA application to determine eligibility, and for the EFC to be reviewed (This requirement does not apply to DACA/Undocumented students).
- You must pay or postpone the enrollment deposit by application deadline to be considered for the award. Priority will be given to those who complete this requirement first.
- You must not have a full-tuition scholarship or award on your account.
- Write a short essay explaining why you need the funding, and discuss your background
- You must identify with one or more of the following demographics: Qualify for free or reduced lunch, first generation, homeless, black or African American, Latino or Latinx, Hispanic, Pacific Islander, Native American, etc.
- You must be an incoming SUU student for the 2023-2024 academic year.

Priority will be given to students who apply by December 1st. The application will open on October 1st 2022, and close on February 1, 2023. Awards will be granted March 1st continuing throughout the spring and summer. The scholarship will start in your first semester of the 2023-2024 academic year at SUU.
