Davis Technical College Programs Disclosure Statement

The objective of our work and training programs is to provide opportunities for skill development, work experience and career preparation. Standards have been established which will enable each student to maximize their opportunity for success.

Students who want to attend DTC are strongly encouraged to attend the DTC orientation, contact DTC for exact times and places.

The DTC offers courses in two time blocks of three hours each. The time blocks are from 8:00 A.M. to 11 A.M. and 12:00 P.M. to 3:00 P.M. Students may contact DTC to begin at an earlier time (7:30am).

Some programs provide evening hours and students should contact DTC for times. Because the block times for the DTC do not align with the regular high school schedules, students will need to be aware of courses that may create conflicts with other high school offerings. Students must know and understand the DTC enrollment requirements and course prerequisites will be necessary before enrolling in DTC courses.

To facilitate training opportunities at the DTC:

- Students should be on track with high school required classes before scheduling college level courses.
- Students should have demonstrated the ability to work independently and show good self-motivation

The DTC Grading Scale is as follows:

А	94% - 100%	B-	80%-83%
A-	90%-93%	C+	77% - 79%
B+	87% - 89%	С	74% - 76%
В	84% - 86%	C-	70% - 73%

DTC Grades below 70% - the student is considered to not have successfully completed the course.

Students attending the Davis Technical College must receive a passing grade from the College in order to earn High School credits.

Note: Students with disabilities may receive an adjusted grade based on accommodations

Students enrolled in a DTC program agree to meet the following requirements:

- 1. Do quality work in the training program.
- 2. Maintain good attendance.
- 3. Maintain a passing grade.
- 4. Arrive at the class on time. Excessive tardiness or inappropriate behavior may result in a "U" or removal from DTC.
 - DTC may remove a student from the college if the student has 10 or more consecutive absences or "No Schedule" status.
- 5. Students need to provide their own transportation and parent or guardian must sign in the appropriate space below.

Neither the Davis School District nor Clearfield High School is responsible for student transportation to and from the DTC. The student's parent or guardian has sole responsibility for providing the student transportation to and from the DTC. A student may be approved to drive him/herself to DTC classes by the school CTE Coordinator upon receiving proof that the student or the student's parent/guardian carries all automobile insurance required by state law.
